UNIFORM ITEMS MARKED * MUST BE PURCHASED FROM SCHOOL SHOP AS THEY ARE CRESTED WITH THE SCHOOL BADGE.

Uniform Items – Prep 3 to S5

5 White school blouses long or short sleeved

*1 Tie

* 2 Cardigans

* 2 Skirts

* 8 Pairs navy socks

8 Pairs white ankle (not trainer) socks summer term only

Navy winter tights may be worn October to March only

Plain black leather school shoes

*1 Coat (Prep 3 to S3)

S4 and S5 may wear a smart plain blue or black coat in place of the school coat

* Hair scrunchie (if Prep 6 or below)

Senior School S1 – S5

*1 Blazer

S5 from the Spring Term are to wear smart office dress as detailed below

Lower and Upper Sixth

Smart office dress is to be worn i.e. dress and jacket or skirt, blouse and jacket, trouser suits. (Skirts and dresses must be knee length).

- Toilet bag containing:- soap and soap box or shower gel, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant. (+ Stock of the above to last at least half a term)
- Nit comb, hairbrush, nail clippers, laundry bag, shoe cleaning kit, sewing kit, spare (sew in) name tapes.
- 1 mug (for drinks in boarding house) optional
- 1 padlock and keys
- 1 pair flip-flops – to wear in showers

Casual clothing for free time after school i.e. jeans, t-shirts, sweatshirt etc

Hair and Jewellery – All girls including sixth form

We can take no responsibility for the safe-keeping of jewellery at school, and the only permitted items are plain studs or sleepers for girls with pierced ears – to be worn in the ear-lobe. Students may wear one ring. Bracelets should not be worn during the school day.

Girls with long hair must tie hair back for the school day (with the school scrunchie if Prep 6 or below). **Hair should not be unnaturally coloured or highlighted.**
