TERMS AND CONDITIONS:-

- 1) Fees are **fully inclusive** of all meals, laundry, educational materials and examination fees. Some subjects require field trips and/or specialist materials that are charged for in addition to the termly fee. Sixth form pupils provide their own specialist text books.
- 2) All fees are **fully inclusive** of cover for Pupils Personal Accident Insurance scheme.
- 3) Facilities are available for **Day pupils to remain at School until 5.30pm**, and to **have supper at no additional cost**.
- 4) **15%** reduction for **2nd** child. **25%** reduction for **3rd** child. **40%** reduction for **4th or subsequent** child. See website for 'ready reckoner' sibling discounts.
- 5) Forces parents are entitled to a Prompt Payment Discount on full boarding fees that ensures the Boarding School Allowance always covers approximately 90% of the fee payable.

- 6) Monthly payment of fees is possible through Holmwood Term-Time Credit. For details please contact the Bursar.
 - 7) Individual tuition for pupils with dyslexia or other Intensive Teaching requirements is available at £29.10 per 40-minute lesson
 - 8) Overseas pupils who are not native English speaking are charged £600 per term for 30 individual E.S.L. lessons.
 - 9) Weekly Boarders are *normally* resident Monday to Thursday inclusive, leaving after School on Friday, returning for start of School on Monday each week. Other arrival and departure arrangements can be made upon request.
 - 10) "Occasional" boarding facilities are offered for day pupils, and weekly boarders can remain at School at weekends, on payment of £45 for Seniors and £35 for Preps per night.
 - 11) Dental and Optician appointments are charged at £5 per visit, and Orthodontist appointments are charged at £10 per visit.
 - 12) A book deposit of £200 is required per family by commencement of the first term and is fully refundable when the last child leaves and all expenses have been cleared.
 - 13) Fees and any expense account balances are due and payable in full on or before the first day of term. Where fees are not paid by the due date a surcharge of £50 is payable for the first week and thereafter interest becomes payable, accruing daily at the rate of 15% per annum. An administration charge of £12 is made for each reminder letter.
 - 14) **A full term's notice, by letter addressed to the Principal, must be given before a pupil is withdrawn from the School or a full term's fees in lieu will be due and payable. Such notice must be received by the School before the first day of that term. A "full term's fees" is defined as the fee shown on the current fee list and excludes any reduction by way of bursary, sibling discount or other discount or scholarship.**
 - 15) A full term's notice in writing must also be given of change of status (e.g. from boarding to day pupil) or payment of the difference in the level of fees in lieu of such notice will be due.
 - 16) A full term's notice in writing must be given of any reduction in individual tuition lessons or payment of the difference in the number of lessons in lieu of such notice will be due.
 - 17) A full term's notice in writing must be given of any reduction in nursery sessions attended or payment of the difference in the number of sessions in lieu of such notice will be due.
 - 18) Advance payment of fees will secure future fees at current levels as well as attracting a termly credit on the pre-paid balance. The Bursar can provide details and worked examples of potential savings.
