

From flexi-boarding to short stays to full boarding, boarding at Finborough is offered to children from Year 3 all the way to Sixth Form. We have options to suit families from different locations – whether you reside an hour away, in another country or even if you're more local!





OUR BOARDING Houses

Finborough's boarding houses have recently undergone a substantial refurbishment that includes a new layout for the girls and boys dormitories, modern washroom facilities and communal areas, as well as new furniture and personal spaces throughout. Dormitories are equipped with a desk for each pupil, giving them the space that they need to study at times that suit them.

Across all year groups, pupils come together during evenings and weekends to enjoy time in their shared communal spaces, an environment where Finborough's commitment to character development truly shines.

Our dedicated boarding staff bring warmth and safety to the house, living on site and always on hand to help.


INTERNATIONAL BOARDING

Our experienced Admissions team have in-depth knowledge and experience of supporting international families through the admissions process. Either working with families directly, or with agents, we are committed to giving the best care and attention to each family's situation and ambition.

Finborough School is licensed by UKVI to sponsor international students applying for a child student visa. Our team ensure that each international student feels not only prepared but genuinely welcomed into our school community, fostering a sense of belonging and connection that continues throughout the admission journey.

ACTIVITIES PROGRAMME

The Director of Boarding ensures that homework and relaxation are balanced with a structured range of evening and weekend trips and activities throughout the year.

Evening activities are not compulsory but are offered to boarders throughout the week and we actively encourage participation. These include Art Club, crafts such as jewellery making, cookery and a range of sports. Boarders may use the Sports Hall, gym and music facilities providing they are accompanied by a member of staff. We encourage and support our boarding pupils to join local clubs and groups to enhance their experiences out of school and become involved in the wider community. Examples of this are local sports teams, Scouts and Guides.

Typical weekend activities include:

- Paddle boarding
- Go Karting
- Visits to Cambridge and Bury St. Edmunds
- Visiting the dry ski slope
- Bowling
- Crabbing
- Arts and crafts

PASTORAL CARE

Ensuring a positive boarding experience is paramount to our boarding team and wider staff. Whilst all students will have a form tutor they can approach regarding any aspect of school, someone from the boarding team is always on hand for boarders to ensure they are happy, their opinions are heard and ideas shared. Our boarding community is tightly knit and our boarding staff offer consistent pastoral care and support to all.

What's more, the school also operates a mentoring programme for students who may benefit from peer support from senior students. In addition to drawing on support from their boarding family, our Head Mr. Clark operates an open door policy for all young people, should they wish to speak to him regarding any aspect of their school experience.

Health and well-being are at the heart of our care, with a full-time nurse onsite to ensure students receive all the support they need.

FOOD AND NUTRITION

All meals are cooked on site by Finborough's experienced catering team. Boarding pupils dine with our day pupils in the dining hall during the school day, and as a boarding community for evening meals. Healthy snacks are plentiful and to the delight of pupils, sweeter treats make the occasional appearance! Drinks and light snacks are available in the boarding house.

Mealtimes are a much-loved part of the day at Finborough and our family-style dining, with children and staff engaging in conversation outside of the classroom, acts as an important opportunity to connect with each other on a social level.

Nutrition and a balanced diet are of the utmost importance to everyone at Finborough, ensuring that pupils have enough food to sustain a full day of learning and activity. Our chef creates menus of nutritional value to support the growth and development of all children and young adults in our care, being especially mindful of those whose sporting commitments mean they have long sports training sessions in the evenings and weekends.

ADMISSIONS

Following your initial enquiry to Finborough's admissions team, families are invited to tour the school, be that in person or virtually. A tour offers the best way to see our school in action, and families are encouraged to ask as many questions as possible! We recommend bringing your child with you so they can see the school for themselves, as the tour will include the boarding house and facilities.

Once families have toured the school and met key staff, we ask you to confirm your interest and register your child if you would like to progress their application. Where possible they will be invited to a taster session at our boarding house with our boarding community to get a flavour of life at Finborough, as well as experiencing lessons during the day.

If all parties are in agreement, and references have been collected from previous educational settings, a non-refundable deposit will be payable and a start date agreed.

For students joining the Sixth Form, trials will include an interview with either the Head or Head of Sixth Form and an assessment to determine the appropriate curriculum pathway.
