OUR Programmes

Our programmes run throughout the year, and we welcome both individuals or groups of children and young adults.

The school's flagship Short-Stay Programme offers international students the opportunity to join the school from half a term to a full academic year. During this programme, students are fully immersed in school life, benefiting from an enhanced curriculum, with dedicated English language support, and full integration into the boarding community. Daily activities and trips help students build confidence, friendships, and a deeper understanding of British culture. For those requiring sponsorship, Finborough is a UKVI child sponsor and can provide a CAS for students wishing to stay longer than six months.

Our Residential Holiday Club provides a dynamic blend of daytime activities and evening boarding experiences with other international and domestic students. The Residential Holiday Club appeals to those seeking an experience lasting one or two weeks and can be an ideal stepping stone to longer stays or simply booked as a fun

learning experience to develop confidence and independence.

For schools or agents seeking group experiences, Finborough offers a Group Visit Programme for 10+ students, including academic immersion, cultural trips, and a complimentary place for an accompanying school staff member.

Additionally, Finborough offers three bespoke programmes, each lasting one week, for students wanting a more specialist experience.

- **1. Discover England** An action-packed one-week immersion programme visiting cultural and historic sites in London.
- 2. Performing Arts For students with a flair for performing arts and wishing to develop their confidence and technical performance knowledge.
- 3. Pre-Season sports Technical coaching and development for players looking to enhance their skills.

BOARDING LIFE

Safeguarding and Well-being

Nothing is more important than safeguarding and we have a strong network of people and processes to ensure that the well-being of students is always our highest priority. Our leadership team, tutors, academic staff, boarding staff and peer mentors are all on hand to ensure students joining us are welcomed with open arms and are supported to get the best from their experience with us.

Integration

- Full Boarding Integration: Students live as part of Finborough's boarding community, fully engaged in school life, with a personalised timetable and taking part in evening activities and weekend trips.
- Pastoral Oversight: Each student is assigned a dedicated pastoral lead (e.g. A tutor or residential mentor and Learnability Coach).

 Option for Guardianship: For younger students and for all students joining for longer than half a term, we encourage UK-based AEGIS approved educational guardianship.

Co-Curricular, Social and Cultural Experience

- Daily Activities: A balanced mix of academic lessons, sports, creative arts, and themed clubs and activity sessions.
- Weekly Excursions: Weekly enrichment trips as part of the boarding community designed to immerse students in British culture.
- Social: Evening events that could include quizzes, competitions and in-house games.
- Team-Building and Recreation: Group activities to build friendships inside and outside the classroom.
